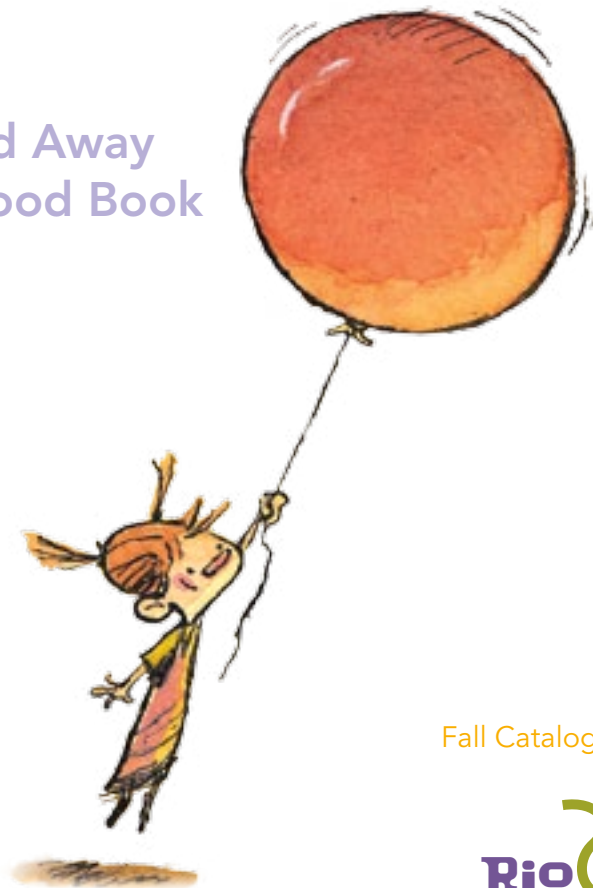

By Carmela LaVigna Coyle

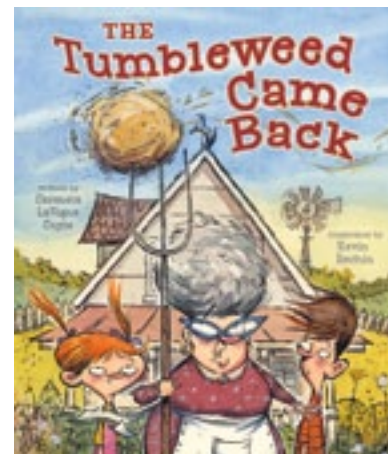
